2. What Are Cookies?

2.3 Cookies may be:

- **Session Cookies** – temporary cookies deleted when you close your browser; or
 - **Persistent Cookies** – cookies that remain on your device until deleted or expired.

3. How We Use Cookies

3.1 assessme.me uses cookies and similar technologies for the following purposes:

- enabling core Website functionality;
- maintaining secure user sessions;
- remembering user preferences;
- improving Website performance;
- monitoring Website usage and traffic;
- detecting security risks and fraudulent activity; and
- supporting login and account functionality.

3.2 Some cookies are essential for the Website to operate correctly and cannot reasonably be disabled without affecting functionality.

4. Types of Cookies We Use

4.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the Website and enable features such as:

- secure login;
- account authentication;
- session management;
- voucher processing;
- assessment functionality; and
- security protections.

Without these cookies, parts of the Website may not function properly.

4.2 Functional Cookies

These cookies allow the Website to remember choices and preferences such as:

- language settings;
 - browser preferences; and
 - user session preferences.

4.3 Security Cookies

Security-related cookies help:

- detect suspicious activity;
- prevent unauthorised access;
- maintain Website integrity; and
- protect user accounts and data.

4.4 Analytics and Performance Cookies

We may use analytics cookies to help us understand:

- how a visitor uses the Website;

- which pages they visit most frequently;
- how they navigate the Website; and
- whether errors occur.

This information helps us improve Website functionality and user experience.

Analytics information is generally aggregated and does not directly identify individual users.

4.5 Third -Party Cookies

There are no third-party cookies.
